3. How would you characterize her faith? What does the Scripture say about her? (Heb 11:31; Jas 2:25-26)

4. Rahab is one of only five women included in the genealogy of Jesus. (Mt 1:5) What does this teach us about God's way of working? How can we be used in God's redemptive history?
